RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: Grey Water Home Owner Assistance program to subsidize or offer free permitting for code compliant home owner grey water systems.

Amount of City Funding Required: \$10,365.00

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.): Essential Services Reserve

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

Currently systems for Single Family "laundry to landscaping" do not require a City Permit and guidelines can be found at www.valleywater.org. Simple Graywater systems that handle more than "laundry to landscaping" but does not exceed 250 gallons would require a half hour plan review and 1 hour of inspection time, and half hour processing time, as well as record retention. (Total cost each is \$414.60). The cost outlined below is for this type of simple permit doing a pilot for 25 single family residences.
