On January 3, 2012, Emily Jafferries was driving on her way to work at the corner of Dumbarton, at Curtner Ave. It was a foggy day, decreasing visibility, however vehicular traffic continued at a pace above the posted speed limit. Ms. Jafferries lost her life as she attempted to make a left turn onto Curtner Avenue.

In addition to this horrific accident, this area of Curtner contains an electronic speed monitoring sign for westbound traffic, the addition of an eastbound sign would complement and complete the pair of signs in each direction.
