RECOMMENDATION

That the following recommendation be enacted.

Proposal

Program/Project Title: District 4 Traffic Calming

Amount of City Funding Required: \$ 50,000 (one-time)

Fund Type (i.e. General Fund, C&C funds, etc.): Essential Services Reserve

This change is:

One-time Ongoing

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

Complaints about speeding and other dangerous road & driving conditions are commonplace in a council office. In any given year, a council office might receive hundreds of complaints about speeding and other unsafe road & driving conditions; and while not every complaint is reasonable, many are based in fact. San Jose has 2,432 miles of paved roadway; and we cannot expect our Dept. of Transportation to be aware of every issue which may be the cause of unsafe conditions. It is impossible. We must rely on residents to report issues. Many times, these issues can be addressed through the deployment of relatively inexpensive traffic calming measures. \$50,000 will not address every problem, but it will provide the council office the opportunity to work collaboratively with DOT & District 4 residents in presenting traffic calming measures at 3 to 5 locations in the District.
