

**RECOMMENDATION**

Provide funding to survey all the historical markers within downtown in order to evaluate necessary refurbishment.

Under the now defunct Redevelopment Agency (RDA), historical markers were installed within our downtown to show the rich history of our City. However, after much time has passed since the RDA was in full operations many of those signs have had no maintenance and have fallen into disrepair.
