Program/Project Title: **Upgrade the Southside Community Center Computer lab**

Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (Please describe how change would affect services for San José residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

Southside Community Center is in dire need of an upgrade. The lab currently houses sixteen desktop computers that are well over a decade old and lack up to date programs and applications. The computer lab is used daily on a drop-in basis, by an average of fifteen seniors a day who have limited to no access to computers at home. Though the lab is open to all community members it has become an essential resource to the Southside Seniors that frequent the community center. Upgrading the computer lab would require purchasing new desktops, monitors, accessories, printers, and software. This new technology would allow Southside to increase not only drop-in participation, but also create the opportunity for additional technology-based programming and Gen2Gen engagement. PRNS anticipates that with the upgrade to the computer lab, there will be an increase in demand for technology-based programming at Southside Community Center for older adults, youth, and others to interact and learn from each other.
