- a. 1. **File No. PDC16-041:** Planned Development Rezoning from the LI Light Industrial Zoning District to the CIC(PD) Planned Development Zoning District to allow a ministorage, retail store, gasoline station with six fuel dispensers and canopy, drive-through carwash, and drive-through restaurant uses; and
- 2. **File No. PD16-027:** Planned Development Permit to allow the demolition of an existing warehouse and car repair building structures and allow the construction of a new retail store (3,814 square feet), gasoline station with six fuel dispensers and canopy (3,870 square feet), drive-through carwash (1,086 square feet), a drive-through restaurant (2,494 square feet) with late-night use to 2:00 a.m., and mini-storage buildings (total of 92,116 square feet); and
