Opportunities

- Community Plan to End Homelessness
 - Increase coordination and cooperation between the City, the County, and the Housing Authority
- Provide training and technical assistance
- Maximize the City portfolio to provide access and funds

Develop 778 Housing Opportunities

- Fund **408** Supportive Housing Apartments
 - Second Street Studios (134 apartments)
 - Senter Road (174 apartments)
 - Downtown Supportive Housing (100 apartments)
- Fund **200** Housing Coupons
- Pilot **170** Transitional Housing Opportunities
 - Hotel/Motel (40 SROs)
 - Safe Parking (30 vehicles)
 - Transitional Communities (100 structures)
