June 6, 2018	Campaign Contribution Period Begins. ( <a href="#">SJMC § 12.06.290.</a> )
June 15, 2018	Last Day for Unsuccessful Candidates from the June Election to remove campaign signs. ( <a href="#">SJMC § 23.04.760.</a> )  <i>Candidates moving on to the November Election may keep their signs posted until November 16, 2018.</i>
July 5, 2016	Last Day for Registrar of Voters to certify election results for the June Election. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code § 15301, 15372.</a> )
July 31, 2018	Semi-Annual Campaign Disclosure Statement Due ( <a href="#">FORM 460</a> or <a href="#">470</a> ). ( <a href="#">Gov. Code. § 84200.</a> )  <i>Covers the period June 4 – June 30, 2018.</i>
<b>Noon</b> , July 31, 2018	Deadline to File Ballot Designation Worksheet with City Clerk, by Noon, if the candidate requests in writing a different designation than the one used for the primary election. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code § 13107(e).</a> )
August 8 to November 6, 2018	24-Hour Contribution/Independent Expenditure Reporting Period ( <a href="#">FORM 497</a> ). ( <a href="#">Gov. Code. §§ 82036, 84203.</a> )  <i>Contribution of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate from a single source must be reported within 24 hours of receipt. Non-monetary contribution of \$1,000 or more must be reported within 48 hours of receipt.</i>
<b>Noon</b> , August 10, 2018	Deadline to File Candidate's Statement of Qualifications with City Clerk by Noon. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code. § 13307.</a> )
After 5:00 p.m. August 10 to August 20, 2018	Public examination of Candidate Statements. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code § 13313.</a> )
August 16, 2018	Randomized Alphabet Drawing. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code §§ 13100, 13112.</a> ) Secretary of State will conduct a drawing of the alphabet for determining the order of candidates' names on the ballot.
September 27, 2018	First Pre-Election Campaign Statement Due ( <a href="#">FORM 460</a> or <a href="#">470</a> ). ( <a href="#">Gov. Code §§ 84200.5, 84200.8.</a> )  <i>Covers the period July 1 – September 22, 2018.</i>
September 27 to October 16, 2018	County Voter Information Guide and Sample Ballot Mailing Period ( <a href="#">Elec. Code § 13303.</a> )

TBD	Last Day to dispose of Surplus Campaign Funds if candidate was defeated or elected to office.
