June 8, 2016	Campaign Contribution Period Begins. ( <a href="#">SJMC § 12.06.290.</a> )
June 17, 2016	Last Day for Unsuccessful Candidates from the June Election to remove campaign signs. ( <a href="#">SJMC § 23.04.760.</a> )  Candidates moving on to the November Election may keep their signs posted until November 18, 2016.
July 7, 2016	Last Day for Registrar of Voters to certify election results for the June Election. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code § 15301, 15372.</a> )
August 1, 2016*	Semi-Annual Campaign Disclosure Statement Due ( <a href="#">FORM 460</a> or <a href="#">470</a> ). ( <a href="#">Gov. Code. § 84200.</a> )  Covers the period June 6 – June 30, 2016.
<b>Noon</b> , August 2, 2016	Deadline to File Ballot Designation Worksheet with City Clerk by Noon, if a different designation than was used for the June 7 primary election is requested. ( <a href="#">Elec Code § 13107(e).</a> )
August 10 to November 8, 2016	24-Hour Contribution/Independent Expenditure Reporting Period ( <a href="#">FORM 497</a> ). ( <a href="#">Gov. Code. §§ 82036, 84203.</a> )  Contribution of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate from a single source must be reported within 24 hours of receipt. Non-monetary contribution of \$1,000 or more must be reported within 48 hours of receipt.
<b>Noon</b> , August 12, 2016	Deadline to File Candidate's Statement of Qualifications with City Clerk by Noon. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code. § 13307.</a> )
After 5:00 p.m. August 12 to August 22, 2016	Public examination of Candidate Statements. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code § 13313.</a> )
August 18, 2016	Randomized Alphabet Drawing. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code §§ 13100, 13112.</a> ) Secretary of State will conduct a drawing of the alphabet for determining the order of candidates' names on the ballot.
September 29, 2016	First Pre-Election Campaign Statement Due ( <a href="#">FORM 460</a> or <a href="#">470</a> ). ( <a href="#">Gov. Code §§ 84200.5, 84200.8.</a> )  Covers the period July 1 – September 24, 2016.
October 11, 2016*	First Day of Mailing Sample Ballots & Vote by Mail Period per Registrar of Voters calendar. ( <a href="#">Elec. Code § 13303.</a> )

<b>11:59 p.m.</b> , May 8, 2017*	Last Day to deposit personal funds into campaign bank accounts. ( <a href="#">SJMC § 12.06.295.</a> ) Last Day to retire all campaign-related debts. ( <a href="#">SJMC § 12.06.710.</a> )
June 12, 2017*	Last Day to dispose of Surplus Campaign Funds if candidate was defeated or elected to office. ( <a href="#">SJMC § 12.06.720.</a> ) Surplus Campaign Funds can only be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Returned to the contributors on a pro rata basis;</li> <li>• Turned over to the general fund of the City of San Jose; OR</li> <li>• Used for attorney's fees and other costs in connection with an election contest or recount</li> </ul> ( <a href="#">SJMC § 12.06.720.</a> )
