San Jose Flood Victims Relief Fund Established

More than \$100,000 in donations received in initial hours.

San Jose, Calif. – This morning, San Jose Mayor Sam Liccardo and Silicon Valley Community Foundation established a “San Jose Flood Victims Relief Fund” to help raise funds that can be used to provide assistance to the thousands of families affected by the severe flooding experienced in San Jose over the past two days.

Already, a number of organizations and businesses have generously donated to this fund including:

- Silicon Valley Auto Dealers Association - \$100,000
- San Francisco 49ers - \$20,000

In addition, PG&E has generously pledged to match donations made to the fund, up to \$20,000.
