PROJECTS NEAR THE INTERSECTIONS OF MONTEREY HIGHWAY AND BERNAL ROAD AND MONTEREY HIGHWAY AND BRANHAM LANE

Regarding the nature of these projects:

Location – Bernal Loop Ramp Infield @ Monterey Road (Department of Public Works)

This location is being used as a temporary construction yard by a contractor authorized by the City of San José to work on sanitary sewer rehabilitation projects. The City has used this location for similar projects in the past. The area has temporary chain link fencing with screening fabric. The contractor is scheduled to complete the current project and remove the yard at the end of October 2017.

Location - Monterey Highway and Branham Lane (Department of Transportation, DOT)

At this location, DOT staff recently performed and completed a project to trim several large Eucalyptus trees located within the undeveloped property on the north side of Branham Lane west of the railroad tracks. The tree trimming was performed to clean up and reduce future accumulation of litter, debris and weeds in the areas around and under the trees. Two of the trees were determined to be dead and hazardous, and were removed. No additional work, other than regular weed abatement and litter and debris removal by DOT, is currently planned for this location.
