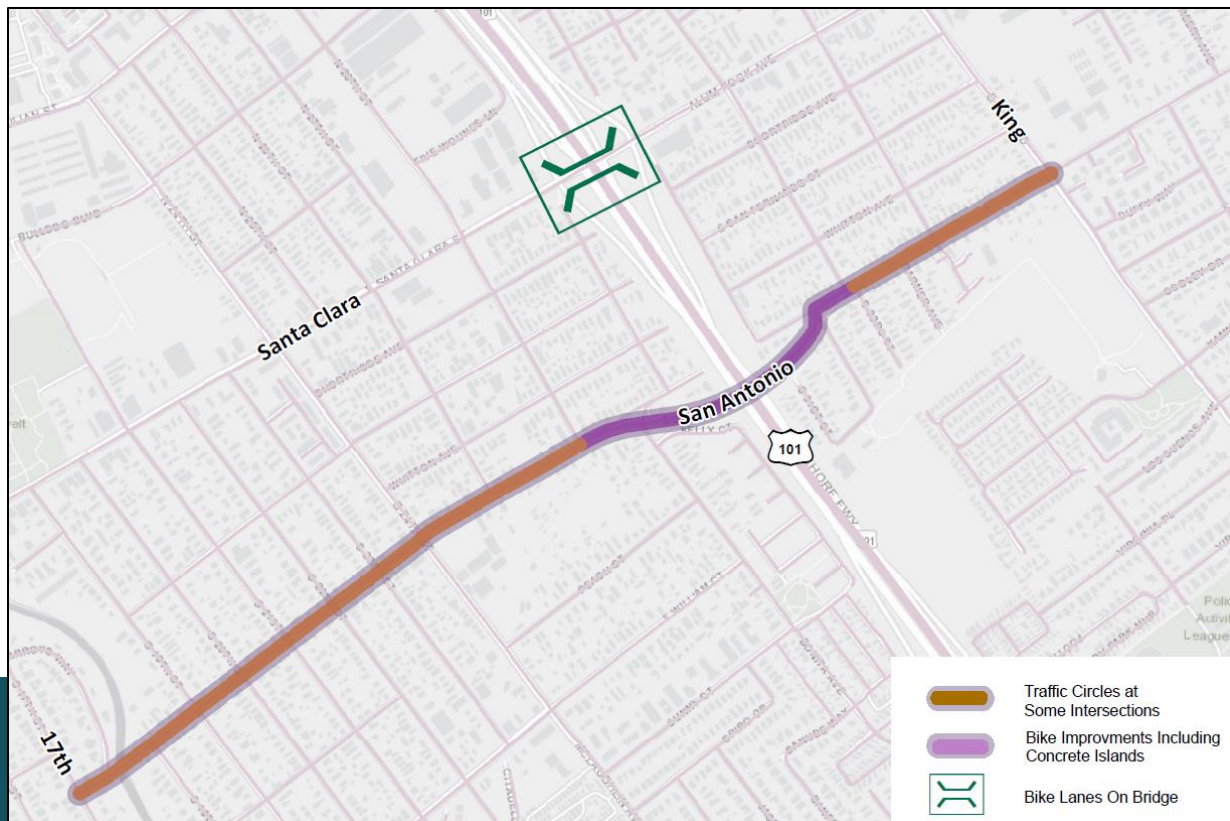

PROJECT SCOPE

The City of San José Department of Transportation is leading an effort to repave San Antonio Street (17th Street to King Road) and Santa Clara Street (30th Street to 31st Street). This project will also improve the bike lanes on San Antonio from 28th Street to 33rd Street, and add a bike lane to the Santa Clara Street bridge over Highway 101. Elsewhere on San Antonio Street, the proposed design will add traffic circles at some intersections to discourage speeding. Preparation work on these two streets has begun. Repaving and striping work are scheduled for 2020, but design plans must be finalized this year.

PROJECT PURPOSE

- **Improve safety** by adding bike lanes and narrowing vehicle lanes
- **Improve access to transit by bike and foot:** VTA Bus Lines 22, 23, 72, 522, and 523
- **Improve neighborhood livability** and quality of life by creating a more comfortable environment to walk and bike
- **Leverage resources** by implementing with the City's annual (2020) Pavement Maintenance Program
