San Jose Fire Department, San Jose Public Library to Host Emergency Medical Services Awareness Activities

San Jose, CA - Monday, May 19th through Friday, May 23rd, the San Jose Fire Department (SJFD) along with San Jose Public Library will join the national emergency medical services (EMS) campaign, *EMS: Your Life is Our Mission*. SJFD will host daily EMS awareness activities at several library branches throughout the city each weekday. The activities are designed to educate adults and children about the EMS system and its appropriate use, injury prevention, personal safety and health awareness. Awareness activities will also include coloring contest for children.
