SUPPLEMENTAL MEMO

The Transportation and Environmental Committee has forwarded to Council, for its consideration, the recommendations for the development of a Request for Proposal to solicit and award exclusive franchises to provide commercial solid waste services.

With regard to the wage issues related to the matter, the City Attorney's Office received a request, on January 28, 2009, from Legal Counsel for Teamsters Local 350, to submit additional analysis regarding the prevailing wage issue. The Transportation and Environmental Committee discussion on prevailing wage versus living wage portion of the commercial solid waste redesign proposal was deferred to the March 2, 2009 T&E Committee meeting in order to give our office an opportunity to review any new information.
