Subject: Bascom Library & Community Center Tilt-up Concrete Panel Installation

Dear Neighbors,

The construction of Bascom Library & Community Center began in fall last year. You might have observed the progress on the construction site and building infrastructure. We are now approaching the milestone of installing building's vertical elements. During the past weeks, the concrete tilt-up wall panels have been formed and cast. Consequently the panels will be ready for installation. The first group of panels is scheduled to be installed on Wednesday, May 27th 2009. Thereafter, two more subsequent panel installations will occur approximately six to eight weeks apart through September 2009.

Please refer to the schedule below for the timeline of the first installation;


- May 26th (7:00 AM -) Equipment arrival and preparation
- May 27th (6:30 AM -) Panel Installation
(Bascom Northbound #2 & #3 lanes and sidewalk will be closed)
(Streetlight Records store and parking lot will be closed until 3:00PM.)
- May 28th (7:00 AM -) Panel Installation will continue and is expected to complete in the afternoon.

Realizing the work will begin a little earlier than usual on May 27th, the contractor plans to start their work in the areas along Bascom Avenue and gradually work their way towards Del Mar Avenue. This work plan should minimize noise and disturbance to the neighborhood in the early morning.

If you wish to witness this event, you are welcome to do so in the designated area outside of the construction fence in the easement driveway between Bascom Avenue and Del Mar Avenue indicated on the attached map. Please exercise extra caution to stay away from the construction area and vehicular traffic.
