Dear Superintendents:

The City of San José needs your help.

As I mentioned at our June 16, 2010 Schools/City Collaborative meeting we have not received a response from your school district regarding our requests for student generation rate and enrollment information. The information provided by your district will facilitate the preparation of the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Envision San José 2040 General Plan Update, which will be used to inform the City Council, Envision Task Force, and the general public of the environmental effects of implementing the Envision 2040 General Plan.

The Draft EIR for the Update is scheduled to circulate for public review this December. To meet this schedule City Planning staff needs your school district's information by **July 9, 2010**.

Item/Link 1 below is a Word document with 4 questions related to the specific requested student generation and enrollment information needed for the EIR.

Items/Links 2, 3 and 4 are intended to help school districts understand the Preferred Study Scenario and how much housing growth capacity is planned within each school district.
