

General Themes

- The community would like to be able to arrange and manage their own activities in the city facilities. Qualified volunteers should be allowed to staff the center with no city employees or janitors present.
- The community wants to see more Cost of Service Information
- Improve way to track volunteering hours
- Thoughtfulness on pricing for low income, youths, seniors.
- Improve accessibility, efficiency, outreach, flow of information.
- Feels that fees are inconsistent and different throughout the City for similar programs.
- Not happy about fee increases, especially when money might go directly to General Fund.
- Pricing flexibility should be looked at more thoroughly and scholarship programs are very important.
- Use of facilities by neighborhood associations should be free / discounted.
- Outside partnerships may help in improving budget woes, improved services, etc.
- Senior nutrition program had a variety of responses, but general idea was not to get rid of it, and not to raise prices too high.
- Improve processes, find alternatives, and provide more analysis and insight on inefficiencies.
- All districts are different in terms of low income, participation in different programs, gang prevention needs, etc.
