

• Notice of Contracts Executed by Council Appointees:

In accordance with Municipal Code Section 4.04.080, titled “Quarterly Reports”, the following is submitted as a report on contracts executed by Council Appointees or designee during the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2017-2018 (July 1, 2017 – September 30, 2017). The list includes contracts or amendments to contracts for services up to \$290,000, contracts or amendments to contracts for grants with a value up to \$290,000, or contracts and amendments to contracts for equipment, supplies, and material with a value up to \$1,170,000.

Purchase Orders for services with a value greater than \$120,000 and up to \$290,000, and for equipment, supplies, and material with a value greater than \$120,000 and up to \$1,170,000 are included in this report.

The “Sole Source” and “Retro” columns are intended to designate if the agreement was issued through a competitive process, or issued retroactively (after the work was initiated). A “Yes” response indicates a sole source or retroactive contract, a “No” response indicates that the contract was competitively selected or not retroactively issued. A “No” response indicates that the action is not applicable, such as amendments, temporary staffing, or contracts issued directly to another public agency.
