

Notice of Contracts Executed by Council Appointees:

In accordance with Municipal Code Section 4.04.080, entitled “Quarterly Reports,” the following is submitted as a report on contracts executed by Council Appointees or designee during the third quarter of Fiscal Year 2017-2018 (January 1, 2018 – March 31, 2018). The list includes contracts or amendments to contracts for services up to \$290,000, contracts or amendments to contracts for grants with a value up to \$290,000, or contracts and amendments to contracts for equipment, supplies, and materials with a value up to \$1,170,000.

Purchase Orders for services with a value greater than \$120,000 and up to \$290,000 and for equipment, supplies, and materials with a value greater than \$120,000 and up to \$1,170,000 are included in this report.

The “Sole Source” and “Retro” columns are intended to designate if the agreement was issued through a competitive process or issued retroactively (after the work was initiated). An “N/A” response indicates that the action is not applicable, such as amendments, temporary staffing, or contracts issued directly to another public agency.
