## MEETING PURPOSE

The City of San José is implementing a shift to measuring transportation impacts under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) to Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) in accordance with State law (SB743). VMT would replace the current method of measuring automobile delay, which is done by analyzing “Level of Service” (LOS) at intersections.
