SB 1214 - PERMISSION TO DISTRIBUTE ARCHITECTURAL DOCUMENTS FORM

<u>Senate Bill 1214</u> (SB 1214) requires local planning agencies to ensure copyrighted architectural drawings are made available to the public in a manner that does not facilitate their copying unless the copyright owner grants permission. Please note that SB 1214 only applies to architectural plan sets. All other plan sets remain public record.

If the design professional or copyright owner does not authorize the sharing of architectural plans, SB 1214 requires that they provide to the planning agency a massing diagram and site plan, as defined in California Government Code 65103.5 (f), for public distribution and online posting. If none are provided at initial submittal, permission is deemed to be granted for public distribution per Government Code Section 65103.5(e).

- Site plan A document for a project that is drawn to scale and displays all of the following: (A) Property lines, (B) Setback lines, (C) Topographic lines, (D) Easements, (E) Drainage, (F) Utilities, (G) Lighting, (H) Driveways, (I) Surrounding streets and traffic flow, (J) Parking lots and parking spaces, (K) Landscaped areas, (L) Setback distance between buildings and property lines, (M) Outline of existing and proposed buildings and structures, (N) Distance between buildings, and (O) Ground sign location.
- Massing Diagram and Site Plan must include the name and contact information of Architectural firm.
