Don't take her babies.

If the kittens are:

- Warm
- Clean
- Plump
- Quiet

Mom is doing her job. She'll be back shortly.

Mom might be missing ...

If the kittens are:

- Cold
- Dirty
- Skinny
- Noisy

Kittens can't regulate their body temperature, so a kitten that is cold, skinny, noisy and/or dirty might be orphaned. Look for sunken bellies, visible bones, or pale skin to confirm mom needs your help.
