Matthew Quevedo opposes the plans of establishment politicians and candidates who want to spend \$1 million per door on homeless housing. The cost of safe and dignified shelter can be just 5% of that. By reducing costs to \$50,000, we can build 20 times more shelter space more quickly, and move our homeless neighbors indoors to end street homelessness in San Jose.
