All other candidates oppose Mayor Matt Mahan's proposal, which allows citations for those refusing shelter three times and for providing Care Courts for treatment.

Matthew Quevedo knows the truly humane approach is utilizing shelter to save lives and protect communities. His plan balances accountability with support, and ensuring those in need receive critical drug and alcohol treatment rather than remaining on the streets.
