### Did Chavez-Lopez violate ethics requirements?

Despite at least \$2 million in property holdings,<sup>1</sup> Chavez-Lopez failed to fully report her income on required ethics documents. She has not explained why she did not disclose her income as required.



### When did Chavez-Lopez move into our district?

While Chavez-Lopez says she “grew up” in our district, her parents did not buy a house here until she was 30 years old. She moved into the district<sup>2</sup> just a few weeks before the filing deadline after her political ally, Omar Torres, resigned in disgrace.



### How does Chavez-Lopez make her living?

In addition to her work promoting politicians, she is a landlord,<sup>3</sup> earning hundreds of thousands of dollars from rents while refusing to support plans to build more quick-build and affordable housing.



### Why didn't Chavez-Lopez pay her property taxes?

She has not said why she did not pay her property taxes<sup>4</sup> despite her very high income level.



### Who supports Chavez-Lopez?

Chavez-Lopez is supported<sup>5</sup> by the Sacramento political establishment and groups like the Working Families Party, long advocates of defunding the police.



### And who supports her opponent?

Her opponent — engineer and housing advocate Anthony Tordillos — is supported<sup>6</sup> by the *Mercury News*, Mayor Matt Mahan, San Jose police officers, and the Housing Action Coalition because he's refusing special interest contributions and has a detailed plan to make our neighborhoods safer and build the new housing we need now.
