



## Public Notice: Pickleball/Tennis Shared Court Pilot Program

### Purpose:

Citywide Sports is launching a Pickleball/Tennis Shared Court Pilot Program on **November 1, 2025**. The program is designed to evaluate a shared-use model that meets growing community demand for both pickleball and tennis while balancing facility use, safety, and neighborhood impacts.

### Program Overview:

Selected tennis courts at **Canoas Park** and **Doerr Park** will be designated for dual use with pickleball during specified days and times.

#### **Canoas Park**

### Pilot Parameters:

- **Duration:** November 1, 2025 – March 31, 2026 (5-month evaluation period)
- **Court Use Schedule:**
  - Pickleball: Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday
  - Tennis: Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday
- **Signage:** Clear signs will be posted at each site showing the schedule, rules of etiquette, and program contact information
- **Alternate Locations:**
  - Pickleball: Paul Moore (1426 Hillsdale Ave), Edenvale (200 Edenvale Ave)
  - Tennis: Wallenberg (1399 Curtner Ave), Houge (3962 Twilight Dr)

## Pickleball/Tennis Shared Court Pilot Program – FAQs

### 1. What is the purpose of this pilot program?

The pilot program is designed to evaluate a shared-use model for tennis and pickleball that meets growing community demand while ensuring safe and fair use of courts and minimizing neighborhood impacts.

### 2. When does the pilot program start and end?

The program runs from **November 1, 2025, through March 31, 2026.**

### 3. Which parks are included in the pilot?

Selected tennis courts at **Canoas Park** (Thursh Dr. & Wren Dr.) and **Doerr Park** (Park Wilshire Dr/ & Potrero Dr.) are included.

### 4. How will court time be scheduled?

- **Pickleball:** Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday
- **Tennis:** Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday

### 5. How will users know the schedule and rules?

Clear signage will be posted at each site showing the schedule, proper etiquette, and program contact information.

### 6. What are the alternate locations if courts are full or unavailable?

- Pickleball: Paul Moore (1426 Hillsdale Ave), Edenvale (200 Edenvale Ave)
- Tennis: Wallenberg (1399 Curtner Ave), Houge (3962 Twilight Dr)

### 7. Can reservations still be made for these courts?
