

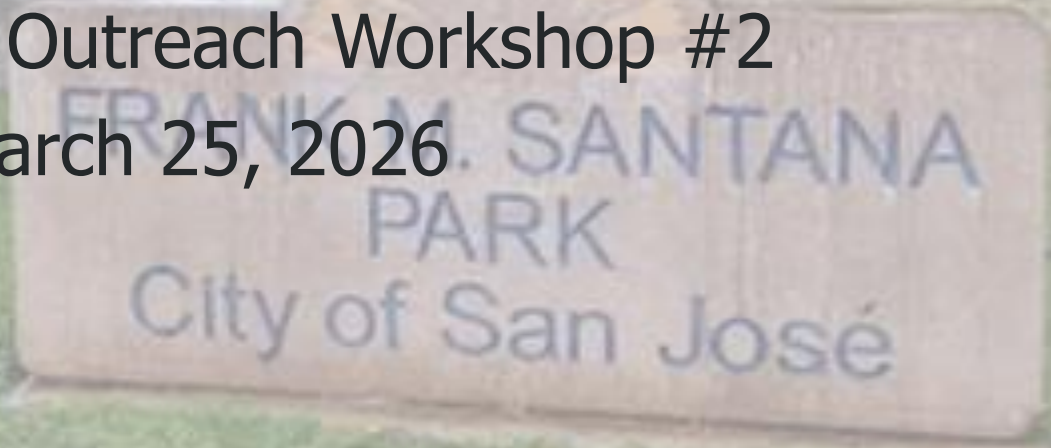

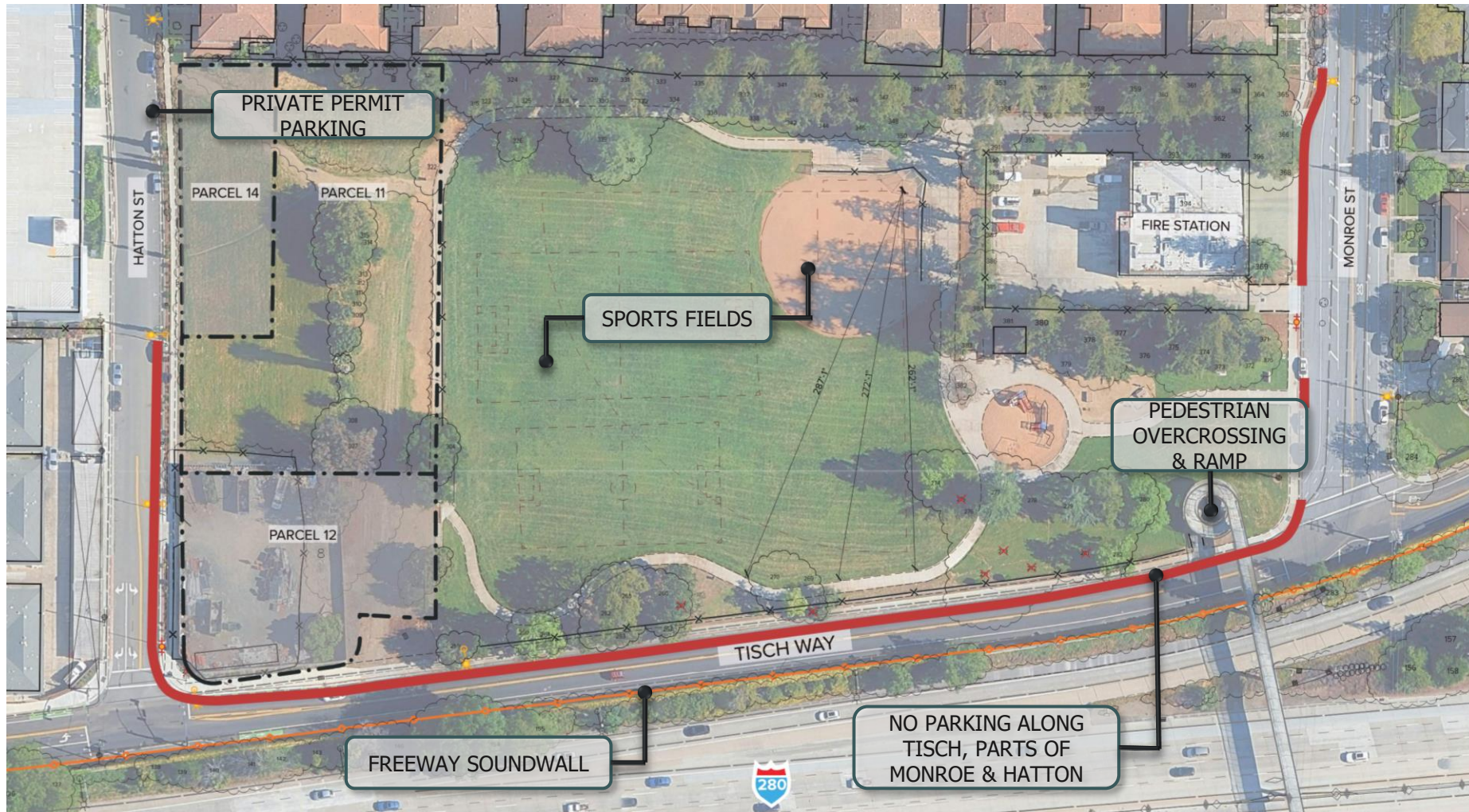
Workshop #1 Recap

- Received Community Feedback (11 in-person, 33 online survey respondents)
 - Walking loop
 - Dog park
 - Recreational amenities
 - Additional shade

Concept Alternative B

- Softball Field Layout
- Path Loop
- Sport Court
- Small Games
- Pollinator Garden
- Sport Court Garden
- Tree Planting and Landscaping



Softball Field Orientation

Alternative A – Southwest



- Pros
 - Close to existing location
 - Sun angle away from defense
- Cons
 - Game play near northern residential neighbors
 - Sun angle toward batter

Alternative B - Northeast



- Pros
 - Optimal sun angle for field orientation & batter
 - Noise away from residential neighbors
- Cons
 - Proximity to pedestrian overcrossing
 - Proximity to Tisch Way



Park Programming Preferences

- Social

- Group activities (game tables)
- Walking paths
- Picnic/Seating areas
- Dog Park



Park Programming Preferences

- Active

- Exercise equipment
- Bocce court
- Sport court
- Small games (cornhole, ping pong, disc golf practice basket)



Park Programming Preferences

- Passive

- Nature paths
- Quiet areas with seating
- Pollinator garden
- Native garden

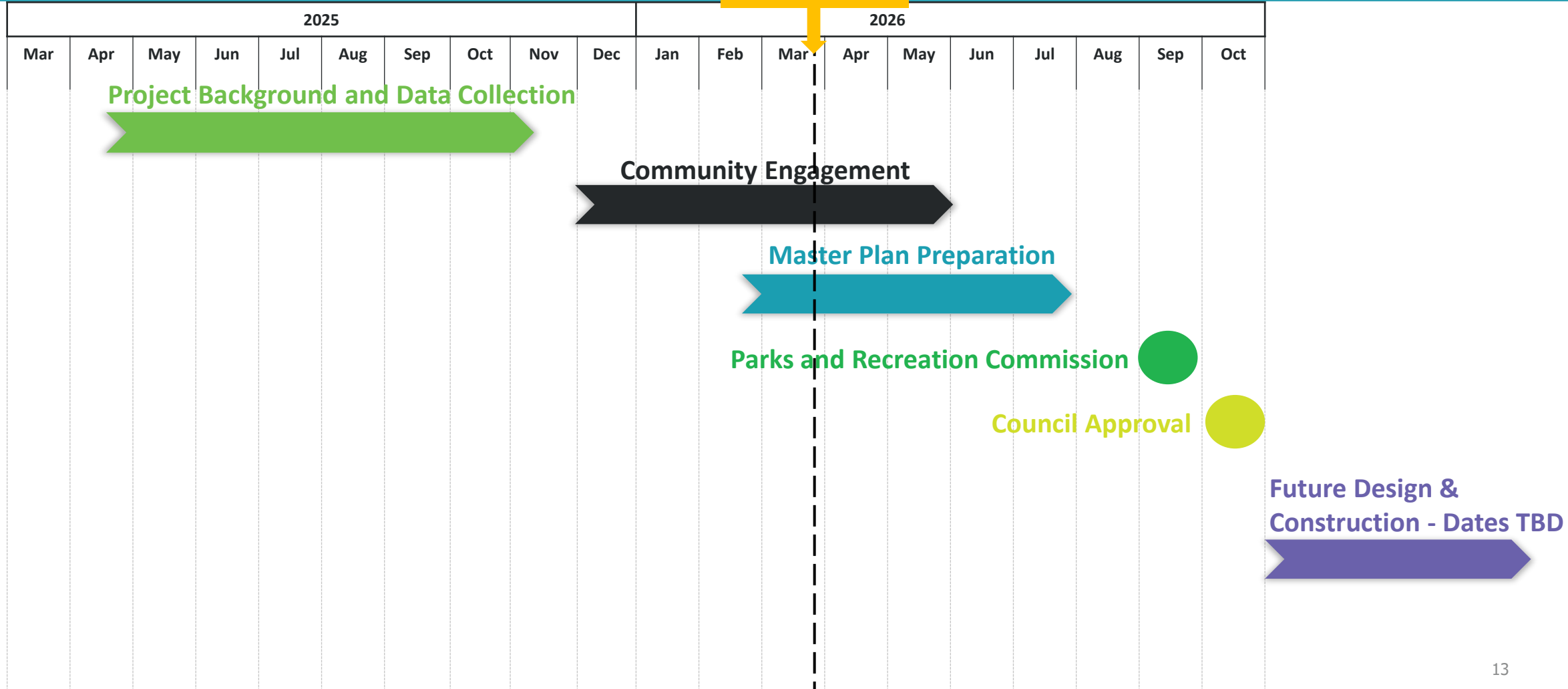
