

Special Event Community Outreach Guidelines

An important part of planning your outdoor special event is Community Outreach. Adequate advance notification to the local community members and businesses affected by your event will ensure your activity is welcomed in the community and will prevent you from post-event work. With these goals, the Office of Cultural Affairs (OCA) has established the following outreach requirements.

Pre-Event Meeting Notifications - OCA Staff will schedule a pre-event meeting with representatives from the departments and agencies who are providing services or permits for your event. This meeting includes stakeholders and representatives from the departments, agencies as well as business and/or neighborhood associations. During this meeting, you will be asked to describe your outreach and event notification process.

Three Weeks Prior to the first event day – Provide OCA staff a draft of your community outreach and advance communication to all addresses, both business and residential, for review and approval by OCA staff.

It is required that Event Organizers work with local community newspapers, online publications, as well as neighborhood association, and business district websites to publicize their events.

A minimum of two weeks prior to the first event day - Event organizers are required to notify all addresses within a 300 foot radius of the event footprint, by written or electronic communication, as well as those that will be land locked by the event street closures. Event organizers have the option of using a Mailing Service to send the notification or a Flyer Distribution Service to hand deliver the notifications door-to-door. Organizers must notify:

1. Adjacent businesses
2. Residents
3. Churches/Schools in the immediate area
4. Event staging area residents and businesses
5. Residents and businesses near the event route, location, or footprint
6. Council district representative's office www.sanjoseca.gov
7. Neighborhood and business associations

Signage - Arrange for advance signage on surface streets/highways notifying motorists of street closures, off-ramp/on-ramp closures etc.

Event Notification must include the following information:

1. Name of the organization(s) producing this event;
2. Day of event contact information for the public, which should include website address, phone number and email address.
3. Name of the Event (Example: Event Notification – NAME OF EVENT)
4. Dates, times of the date(s) of event.
5. Theme or purpose of the event. The Event Organizer can also distribute a Press Release or other media info about the event.
6. Location(s) of the event including road closures, name of parks, trails, and street(s) for event location, name of facility, church, school, or venue being used, as well as portions of event that do not take place within the City of San Jose.
7. Route or map of the event, including the event footprint and written instructions to impacted residences or businesses on with alternate route suggestions to avoid road closures.

Event organizers are required to implement parking control plans for designated residential areas:

1. Market/Almaden neighborhood (for events held at Discovery Meadow)
2. Arena Neighborhood (events on Autumn Street and Arena Green)

San Jose Wonder Woman Run ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

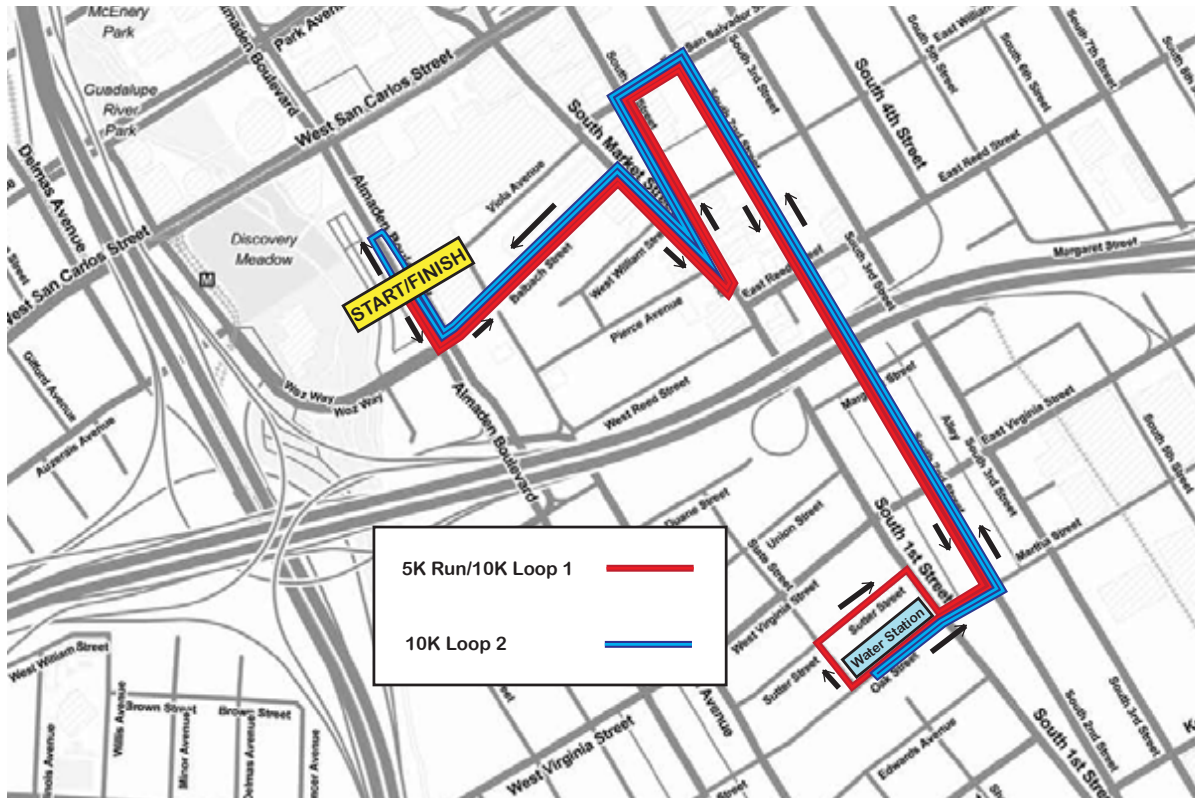
SUNDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2018

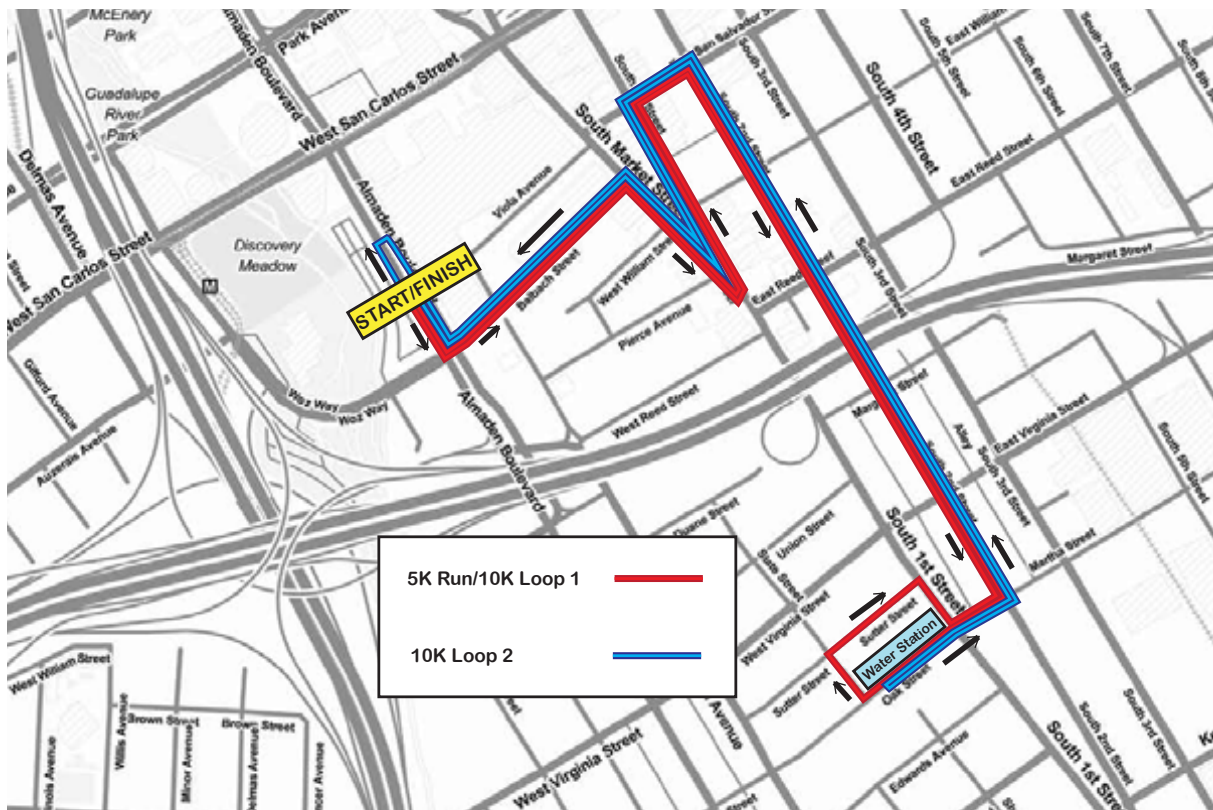
Domingo 21 de Octubre 2018
