As part of the Public Safety budget study session for the 2019-2020 Proposed Operating Budget on Thursday, May 9, 2019, Councilmember Foley inquired as to the number of cameras on the City's Camera Registry Program<sup>1</sup>. This program allows residents and business owners to register the locations of their video surveillance systems with the Police Department. When a crime occurs, police will be able to identify the locations of nearby video cameras and enlist the assistance of the community to help officers collect video evidence and follow up on leads.

The City's Camera Registry Program currently has 808 cameras registered.
