


# Home Fire Escape Plan

## How to make a home fire escape plan:

- Draw a floor plan of your home. Show all windows, doors, porches, porch roofs, and stairways.
  - Choose and mark a meeting place outside in front of your home.
  - Mark two ways out of each room. Use a different color for each escape route. You'll use this as your backup plan in case your primary escape route is blocked or unsafe to use.
  - Practice your plan at least twice a year.
- i** Children should be closely supervised during drills in the home. Don't take unnecessary chances.
  - i** In case of a fire or emergency, call 9-1-1.
