For several years, our downtown has experienced a density growth of both housing and office. With this growth, there is also an increased traffic impact to the surrounding neighborhoods of District 3. Despite each district receiving traffic calming funds, our district has found that additional funding is needed to address major concerns from residents. Through this one time funding over the years, our office has been able to work with residents and staff to improve the safety of our streets in parts of Japantown, Northside, McKinley Bonita, and Guadalupe Washington. However, this only addresses a portion of the needs in our neighborhoods, and we hope to be able to provide the necessary relief to the safety of streets within District 3.
