Provide funding for two additional enhanced street sweeping in District 3

Proposal

Proposal Description, including the reason for the need and anticipated outcomes (Please describe how the proposal will affect services for San José residents, community groups, businesses, etc.):

To increase the maintenance and beautification of our streets, our city has street sweeping in many of our neighborhoods. However, in some instances we do not have “No Parking” signs in needed areas. This can cause street sweeping to be ineffective and an increase of blight and debris can occur. In discussion with our Street Sweeping team, each Council District receives about two enhanced street sweeping locations. We know the capacity of staff is limited, and our residents demand for more cleaner streets to help improve living conditions within the community. We also know that cleaning the debris on our streets helps protect our environment, as it eliminates the amount of trash that flows to our streams and creeks through the storm drains. Until we can increase our staffing and capacity for more parking enforcement and “No Parking” signs on street sweeping days, we request that District 3 receives the funding for an additional two enhanced street sweeping for impacted areas.
