Proposal Description, including the reason for the need and anticipated outcomes (Please describe how the proposal will affect services for San José residents, community groups, businesses, etc.):

Kooser Road, at Stanwood, is a busy roadway, with the Princeton Plaza, a busy retail strip mall, located to the south, and residential and retail on the north. Currently, there are very few places along this traffic corridor to safely cross Kooser between Meridian Ave. and Blossom Hill Road. Additionally, this area has experienced a fatal hit-n-run within the past year.

The residents in this neighborhood and those who frequent the shopping center or local eateries have long requested the enhancement of the existing crosswalk at Kooser/Stanwood. The crosswalk would include high visibility markings and flashing beacons. Additionally, we would request a study to explore the feasibility of adding curb extension/bulb-outs, a median refuge island, and reconstruction of curb ramps.
